

## DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING

### OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; ½ Level; Reopening)

5-card overcalls, at 1st level possible with bad suit

OC 2♣ on 1♣ = NAT, 2♦ on 1♣ = MCB, 3♣ on 1♣ = UNT

1M/m – DBL(LHO) – 2oM/om = NF

1M/m – 2M/m(LHO) – 3oM(om) = WJR

Advancer's SUPP = INV, CUE = SUPP & F

Advancer's new suit level 1/3 = F1, level 2 = NF

### 1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)

2<sup>nd</sup>: 15 - 18 HCP with stopper, Syson

4<sup>th</sup>: 15 - 18 HCP with stoppers, NAT  
R/O = 11 - 14 HCP with stopper, Syson

### JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)

WJ overcalls, strength depends on distribution & vulnerability

(1M) – 2NT = 5+♣ & 5+♦

(1 m) – 2NT = 5+♥ & 5+ om, 1♣ - 3♣ = 5+♠ & 5+♦

### DIRECT AND JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Responses; Reopen)

Bids showing 2-suiters are made with weak hands

(1M) – 2M = oM & undefined m

(1 m) – 2 m = 5+♥ & 4+♠

Jump CUE = ASK for stopper.

#### NATURAL TWO OVER ONE ALMOST GF

We open 5 card M, better m

1NT = 15-17 HCP, 2NT = 20-21

2♦ = multi, 2♥♠ = Muiderberg, 2♣ GF

GF 3NT = gambling

4♣/♦ = Namyats

We lead 4th best from long suit

We use standard Hi, Lo signals for ATT & CT

NMF, Reverse Drury, Bergen, , 4th suit forcing

1NT: 4 TRF, Smolen, NF STAY, SA Texas, Supp Acc responses

UNT & Michaels CUE on 2<sup>nd</sup> position
